## The Dinner Options:


Roast prime rib au jus with horseradish

## "The InSight Landing Site on Mars: Testing our Predictions and First Observations"




Dr. Nicholas Warner is an assistant professor in the Department of Geological Sciences at SUNY Geneseo. Following his PhD at Arizona State University, his postdoctoral work at Imperial College (London) and then at the Jet Propulsion Lab (Cal Tech and NASA) got him directly involved in the InSight project. He has been working for the past several years to determine the best landing site for the InSight spacecraft. As one of only a handful of geologists who work on this mission, his role was to evaluate satellite imagery of the surface of Mars to identify a safe region for landing, as well as to evaluate soil properties at the landing site. This involved measuring surface characteristics such as terrain slope, elevation, impact ejecta rock abundance, and soil thickness. Several Geneseo undergraduate geology majors have been involved in these analyses with him, resulting in multiple publications and mission-related responsibilities. The final landing site chosen was in Elysium Planitia on the planet's northern plains. Dr. Warner and his current student researchers were invited to the Jet Propulsion Lab to witness the successful landing last November, and he continues to be involved in the ongoing mission.



## **Directions to Terry Hills Golf Club:**

Take **490 West** to exit 2. Bear right onto Route 33 West. Continue on Route 33 West for 11 miles, crossing over the Thruway. Terry Hills is just before Batavia, on the left. **Note that there is NO exit onto 33 from the Thruway**.
